Job Summary: Applications are invited for a Senior Lecturer position in Animal Physiology. The applicant must have a PhD and appropriate research and teaching experience in Animal Physiology. The School of Animal, Plant and Environmental Sciences is a leader in several disciplines locally and globally, and is one of the top Schools in the Faculty of Science in terms of research output and postgraduate throughput. We have world class facilities for conducting research, including appropriate laboratory facilities, equipment and access to field sites.

Minimum qualification / requirement

- PhD in Zoology, specialising in Animal Physiology
- Experience in teaching undergraduate courses
- A research track record of publication and postgraduate student supervision, appropriate for a senior lecturer
- Ability to attract independent research grant funding
- Excellent oral and written skills in English
- Valid driver's licence (at least code B)

Personal attributes

The ideal candidate should have the following:

- Collegiality and the ability to work with other members of staff
- Ability to work in a collaborative research network
- Enthusiasm and passion for teaching and research

Field of research:

We welcome applications from people with knowledge of Animal Physiology, and research skills in evolutionary physiology, ecophysiology, thermal physiology, climate change responses and/or conservation physiology. Proficiencies in experimental design and quantitative skills are essential.

Key Performance Areas:

The candidate is required:

- Teach at undergraduate and honours levels, as well as engage in curriculum development and course coordination
- Organise practical sessions and fieldtrips where applicable
- Develop an independent research programme focused on animal physiology
- Provide appropriate training and supervision of postgraduate students
- Contribute to the running of the School
